

# Itinerary and pricing for the Reunion

## R12RT Tour

27<sup>th</sup> February – 10<sup>th</sup> March

2 Weeks South Island Tour

&

11<sup>th</sup> March – 17<sup>th</sup> March (North Island extension)

### Day 1

#### Christchurch

Officially known as arrival day, if you are flying in we will collect you with a warm welcome and take you to the hotel so you can spend a relaxing day getting over *that* flight. For those who have arrived the day before (or earlier) there is a day ride to Akaroa and back. Dinner tonight for all and our first get together 😊

### Day 2

#### Mount Cook

We head out of town down south across the Canterbury Plains and turn inland towards Geraldine where not far afterwards we enter the fabulous McKenzie Country. Lake Tekapo with its azure blue water is along the way and Mount Cook awaits you.

### Day 3

#### Dunedin

Larnach Castle is the destination but along the way we have SHW 83 with the hydro dams to ride along and our first glimpse of Otago, a region that offers the most awesome roads. The Castle is where a misty foggy night really adds atmosphere to the place, sounds odd but it's ok to wish for inclement weather here!

## **Day 4 & 5**

### **Te Anau**

Farm-stays for 2 nights and a day ride to Milford Sound where we take a ½ day cruise in the Sound. Home style cooking, gracious hosts, and awesome riding makes these 2 days spectacular. Milford Sound will be a memorable trip and is one of the worlds' most scenic routes.

## **Day 6 & 7**

### **Queenstown**

Today we can go the long way or the short way. The long route will be via Invercargill for a stop off at E Hayes and Sons Ltd where the Bert Munro display of the 1960 600cc Indian Scout is displayed along with lots of Berts memorabilia. The short way is only 2 hours or so for those in a hurry to get to Queenstown where you can jump, speed, sail, fly, ride, just about anything!

## **Day 8**

### **Fox Glacier**

You know this road!! SHW 6 along the West Coast of the South Island is the stuff of legends. Relive that beautiful ride up to Fox Glacier and think about taking a helicopter ride up to the top of the glacier. Well worth the experience.

## **Day 9**

### **Hanmer Springs**

The first of the Passes today, leaving SHW 6 we head inland on the Lewis Pass to the little alpine village of Hanmer Springs. This Pass offers ever changing scenery from West Coast rain forest to mountainous heights, to open plains and river beds. A brilliant ride on a fine day, this road gives bends that will keep you smiling all the way through!

## **Day 10 & 11**

### **Nelson**

It's the East Coast today that we ride up towards Nelson on and into the wine district we go! Kaikoura offers whale watching along the way if you want (early start from Hanmer can make this happen) or perhaps a few stops along the way at some of the finest Sauvignon Blanc wine producers in the world! On your second day in Nelson there is a day ride over the hill to Collingwood or a stroll around the city of Nelson the home town for many of NZ's artists.

## **Day 12**

### **Punakaiki**

Woo hoo! Back on the road thru exquisite farm land and rolling hills and back onto SHW 6 ☺ If you get an early start on the day you could ride up to Karamea which is the end of the line for SHW 6. Beach front accommodation tonight ☺

### Day 13

#### Christchurch

Today we ride over our second Pass, it's up and over Arthurs Pass and down onto the Canterbury Plains. Remember to watch out for the Kea birds if when you stop for lunch and photos in Otira or Arthurs Pass, these smart birds will rip the bike seat apart the moment you turn your back! This is our final night on the deluxe two week tour and for some their final night in NZ.

### Day 14

#### Departure Day

We will take you to the airport and sadly wave bye bye....For some though, it will be a short flight up to Auckland to start your 6 night Self Guide adventure!

**All pricing includes** - accommodation, all with private facilities, meals (South Island tour), unlimited mileage, full motorcycle insurance, motorcycle accessories such as top boxes, tank bags, GPS, riding gear, airport transfers, tour book, maps, tour t-shirt.

**All pricing excludes** - Flights to/from New Zealand, travel insurance, optional CDR bike insurance, pre-/post-tour accommodation (all of these may be arranged through us), petrol, personal items and expenses.

To reserve your position on the tour it is the normal process, contact us advising your bike selection and what you want with it IE top box, tank bag, lowered seat, taller seat etc. We send you a quote, and 20% of the total will secure your booking.

When booking your international flights it would pay to try and add the internal flight of Christchurch – Auckland on the 11<sup>th</sup> March which could end up virtually free, however if you don't have an agent to do this for you, keep an eye on the specials that come up from time to time. You can get flights one way under \$100.00 at times by booking early.
